HWTF CHAIR LT. GOV. BEVERLY PERDUE LAUDED BY FAMILY PHYSICIANS FOR ADDRESSING CHILDHOOD OBESITY

Lt. Governor to be honored with the North Carolina Academy of Family Physicians' Distinguished Service Award

(Raleigh, NC) – Lt. Governor Beverly Perdue, chair of the NC Health and Wellness Trust Fund (HWTF), will receive the Distinguished Service Award from the North Carolina Academy of Family Physicians (NCAFP) for her work addressing childhood obesity. The award will be presented to Lt. Gov. Perdue at the association's Spring Family Physicians Weekend in Wrightsville Beach on Friday, April 8, 2005.

The Distinguished Service Award, awarded annually, recognizes individuals annually who work in the best interest of family medicine to improve family and community health. NCAFP Board Chair and Immediate Past President Dr. Conrad L. Flick, a Cary family physician, will be presenting this award to Lt. Gov. Perdue. Under her leadership, HWTF has taken a leadership role in finding solutions to combat the growing childhood obesity epidemic in North Carolina.

In 2003, HWTF created a Study Committee on Childhood Obesity, *Fit Families NC*, that recently released seven legislative policy recommendations. These were developed with input from school, public health and industry representatives and included physical activity and child nutrition standards. In addition, HWTF joined forces with Blue Cross and Blue Shield of North Carolina (BCBSNC) last year to launch the *Fit Together* Initiative which includes 21 community-based grants around the state, a statewide media campaign, and a content-rich Web site, designed to promote healthy lifestyles.
