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GENERAL GRANT APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The General Grant application process includes two steps:

- The first step informs the Health and Wellness Trust Fund Commission (HWTFC)
 of your interest in receiving funding and briefly describes your proposed program.
 The Letter of Intent and Agreement and Certification are completed at this stage.
- 2. The second step is the submission of your full program proposal. At this stage, the *Application* is completed. These steps are further described below.

Step I: Letter of Intent and Agreement and Certification

To begin the application process, applicants must submit a *Letter of Intent* and a signed *Agreement and Certification* form to HWTFC. These forms can be found at http://www.hwtfc.org/htmfiles/fundprty_gengrants.htm.

The completed documents should be mailed to: HWTFC, 7090 Mail Service Center, Raleigh, NC 27699-7090. If using a courier or overnight service, send the documents to 501 N. Blount Street, Raleigh, NC 27604-1119.

These documents must be submitted prior to submission of a General Grant *Application*, but must be postmarked no later than July 1st for consideration for the following annual funding cycle – January 1st of any year through December 31st of that same year.

Step II: Application

The *Application* describes in detail the proposed program of work, organizational history, need for services, planned budget. The format can be found at http://www.hwtfc.org/pdffiles/generalapp2.pdf.

General Grant Application Instructions (continued)

The *Application* must be postmarked no later than August 1st for consideration for the following annual funding cycle – January 1st of any year through December 31st of that same year.

Applications received by HWTFC prior to receipt of a Letter of Intent and Agreement and Certification will not be considered for funding until all completed documents are received as specified above.
